

awe as you read of the transformational power of God's Word among the Dani tribes.




9. Hope for Hurting Hearts

a broken heart to others who also have broken hearts."




8. Learn to Study The Bible

a year. Each day teaches from a specific text, with devotionals beginning in Genesis and ending in Revelation.




6. For Better

book shares the why of missions, 25 essential missionary biographies, and hundreds of practical ideas.




4. Kabul 24




3. Grace Today




2. Intensive Faith
