


Hearing His Voice:

Discerning the will of God can be a difficult process. In *Hearing His Voice*, Jim Gallagher, senior pastor of Calvary Chapel Vero Beach, FL, uses the true story of a mission trip to Africa to describe how to distinguish God’s will in confusing times.

The book combines details of this trip with Bible stories. “We must learn to distinguish the good from the bad. But it is often more difficult to distinguish between the good and the best,” Jim writes. He addresses the pitfalls of not taking time to ask God’s will, forgetting that God’s Word is His primary means of communication, and relying too heavily on the advice of friends and family. In the book, one “failed” mission trip showed “how greatly He can use our lives when we are willing to surrender to Him,” Jim says.




Inductive Bible Study:


The Privilege:

“Oh, my word, what does a pastor’s wife do?” Kay Smith, widow of the late Chuck Smith, spoke these words in the early days of her husband’s pastoral ministry. In later years, she wrote *The Privilege* to encourage and exhort not only pas-

tors’ wives but mothers, Sunday School teachers, and ministry leaders to thrive in their special calling as nurturers. She shares the lessons she’s learned from both her mistakes and victories over 60 years. “I would tell you to do the following: love the Lord, love your husband, love your children, and love the people,” she writes. Topics in the book include pursuing a right relationship with God, practicing submission in marriage, valuing the gift of brokenness, and maintaining an eternal perspective.

This single volume of two books—studies of First and Second Corinthians—reminds Christians that despite struggles, they can still experience a life of blessings. It is based on a series of sermons from the late Alan Redpath, an evangelist and pastor in

England, Scotland, and America for three decades. Although the Apostle Paul penned his letters to the believers of Corinth centuries ago, the message is still applicable to the church today. The book is written for readers with “a hungry heart to which God has revealed the shallowness and ineffectiveness of the church today.” He further challenges the church to take action: “In the light of the judgement seat of Christ, how can we possibly allow things to go on as they are?”
